MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

GOVERNMENT ARTS AND COMMERCE COLLAGE, TALALA GIR

&

DHARMENDRASINHJI ARTS COLLEGE, RAJKOT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION

The general objective of this memorandum of understanding (MOU) is to stimulate and facilitate the development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programs which serve to enhance the intellectual life and cultural development on both campuses and to contribute towards the overall growth of both the colleges by increasing academic cooperation. Thus, Government Arts and Commerce College- Talala and Dharmendrasinhji Arts College, Rjkot have agreed that in support of their mutual interests in the field of education and research:

- 1. Both of the Educational Institutions will:
 - a) Cooperate for teaching and learning initiatives.
 - b) Carry out Research activities by the joint venture between both the institutions.
 - c) Organise Faculty Exchange Programs for developing specific courses to cater the need of the interdisciplinary studies and research.
 - d) Organise Social, cultural, educational and professional activities to serve the society and the national duties.
 - e) Plan and execute Seminars, conferences, workshops, symposia of state, national and

international level collaboratively.

- f) Allow and encourage mutual visit of each other's institute for exchange of ideas for the overall development of the institutes.
- g) Share their students as well as faculties to expand the horizon of Interdisciplinary and multi-disciplinary Study in order to bring out better research in Higher Education.
- h) Conduct various activities to find out Innovative Minds from the Youth of Colleges

under programmes of government like SSIP 2.0 (Student Startup and Innovation Policy) and Innovation Club.

2. The faculties will be facilitated with the infrastructural as well as digital resources at the host college. The library i.e. knowledge resources will be made available to the faculties of the guest college. The guest faculties should handle all the resources carefully and bind with the terms and conditions of the host college.

- 3. Faculties will focus upon quality education under the guidance of IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell), SQAC (State Quality Assurance Cell), NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council), NIRF (National Institutional Ranking Framework), GSIRF (Gujarat State Institutional Ratting Framework) and exchange novel ideas and strategies to improve the standard of Knowledge as well as techniques of providing the knowledge.
- 4. The faculties will also pave the way for holistic development of the students in accordance with the current planning of NEP 2020.
- 5. The aim of the Memorandum of understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both colleges.
- 6. In the implementation of specific cooperative programmes, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and obligations to be undertaken by each college will be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalized in writing, prior to the commencement of the programme.
- 7. The agreement will be effective from the date of its signing and shall be valid for two academic years from that unless sooner termination, revoked or modified by mutual written agreement between both the institutes and may be extended by mutual written agreement.
- 8. Either of the college may terminate the Agreement at any time during the term by the provision of three months prior written notice to the other college.
